## Biography Wax Museum

<i>What?</i> The third annual 3 <sup>rd</sup> grade biography wax museum!
<i>When?</i> May 2, 6:00pm-7:00pm
<i>Where?</i> Smith Gymnasium
<b>Who?</b> All 3 <sup>rd</sup> graders and their families
Why? As the 3 <sup>rd</sup> grade classes explore the nonfiction genre of biography in school, we ask you to help your child choose a famous person they'd like to know more about and be ready to share their knowledge with others.

At wax museum night you'll pretend you are that person and will share the valuable information you learned from reading the biography. □Step 4: Create a note card or 2 with important facts for museum night.
