The town of Lincoln continues to do work on water mains on Lincoln and Bedford Roads. For our Lincoln School families, we anticipate that this work will continue to impact bus routes and lead to traffic delays. To the greatest extent possible, the town is trying to delay the work until after school arrival each day, but they may not be able to maintain that schedule on a consistent basis.
