# Welcome to the Hanscom After School Beginner Instrumental Program!

We're excited to offer a wonderful opportunity for students to begin their musical journey with our after school beginner instrument classes. Our program is designed to make music accessible and enjoyable, helping students develop essential skills in a supportive and engaging environment.

#### **Our Goals**

The Hanscom After School Beginner Instrumental Program aims to:

- Enhance Musical Skills: Teach fundamental instrumental techniques.
- Develop Music Reading Skills: Learn to read and understand music.
- **Develop Ensemble Skills:** Rehearse and perform music as a group.
- Offer Performance Opportunities: Each class will participate in at least one concert per year.

Note: Group lessons are free of charge. Families will need to rent their own instruments.

### **Program Offerings**

#### **Beginner Group Lessons Include:**

- Clarinet
- Flute
- Percussion (Drums)
- Saxophone
- Trumpet
- Trombone
- Violin and Viola

#### **Class Details:**

- Setting: Small group lessons after school.
- **Instruction:** Taught by <u>qualified instructors</u> specializing in specific instruments or families of instruments. For example, clarinet and saxophone students might be grouped together, while trumpet and trombone students will have their own class.

**Cost:** There is no charge for the group lessons beyond the cost of instrument rental. Students who complete one year of beginner lessons are encouraged to transition to private lessons.

- Class Duration: 33 consecutive weeks (excluding vacation weeks), starting the week of September 16, 2024, and ending the week of May 23, 2025.

- **Concerts:** Students will participate in at least one Hanscom Music Department concert per school year.
