For Returning Students:

• **Priority Scheduling:** Contact your current teacher directly to secure your lesson slots. All fees must be paid before the first lesson.

Registration Fee:

• \$35 per child (nonrefundable)

Private Lesson Fees:

30 minutes: \$1,072.50 (33 lessons @ \$32.50 each)
45 minutes: \$1,584 (33 lessons @ \$48.00 each)
60 minutes: \$2,095.50 (33 lessons @ \$63.50 each)

Installment Payments:

30 minutes: \$357.50 per installment
45 minutes: \$528.00 per installment
60 minutes: \$698.50 per installment

Note: A \$35 registration fee is added to the initial payment.

Initial Payment: Due on or before Sept. 13, 2024
Installment #2: Due on or before Nov. 18, 2024
Installment #3: Due on or before Feb. 10, 2025

Schedule

- Lessons: 33 consecutive weeks, excluding vacation weeks, from Sept. 16, 2024, to May 23, 2025.
- Make-Up Weeks: May 26, June 9 (for missed lessons due to teacher cancellation, holidays, or inclement weather).
- **Recitals:** Scheduled for the week of June 2, 2025. Teachers may hold recitals during other weeks and will notify you in advance.

Note: Teachers will deduct one lesson per child, per recital to offset the time and preparation which recitals demand.

Financial Responsibilities

 Make-Ups: Granted only for teacher illness, school cancellations due to weather, or holiday observances. Recital participation can count as a lesson.
