Rainbow Club is an elementary school, **developmentally appropriate** version of the middle school's GSA (Gender and Sexuality Alliance). The club is co-facilitated by Shelley Moeller, School Social Worker, and Taryn Caira, Art teacher. We will address topics such as identity, family, and respect.

Rainbow Club is divided into 2 groups: one group for 1st-2nd graders, one for 3rd-4th graders. Each group will meet once a month on **Wednesdays from** 12:00-12:30. Activities may include a read aloud and a craft project.

Our Mission:

To allow LGBTQ+ students and allies to connect and hold space for each other; to promote a safe, healthy, anti-bullying school climate; and to foster and develop our CARES values, such as:

Cooperation: Taking responsibility for what you say and do, working together to improve our community, learning what it means to be an ally.

Assertion/ Respect: Advocating for making Lincoln School a safe and welcoming place for all students, regardless of their gender identity.

Empathy: Supporting LGBTQ+ members of our community, demonstrating empathy to ourselves and others, welcoming different opinions.

Information about Rainbow Club will be presented to 1st-4th grade students next week. Students will require permission from caregivers in order to attend. Groups will begin in October.
