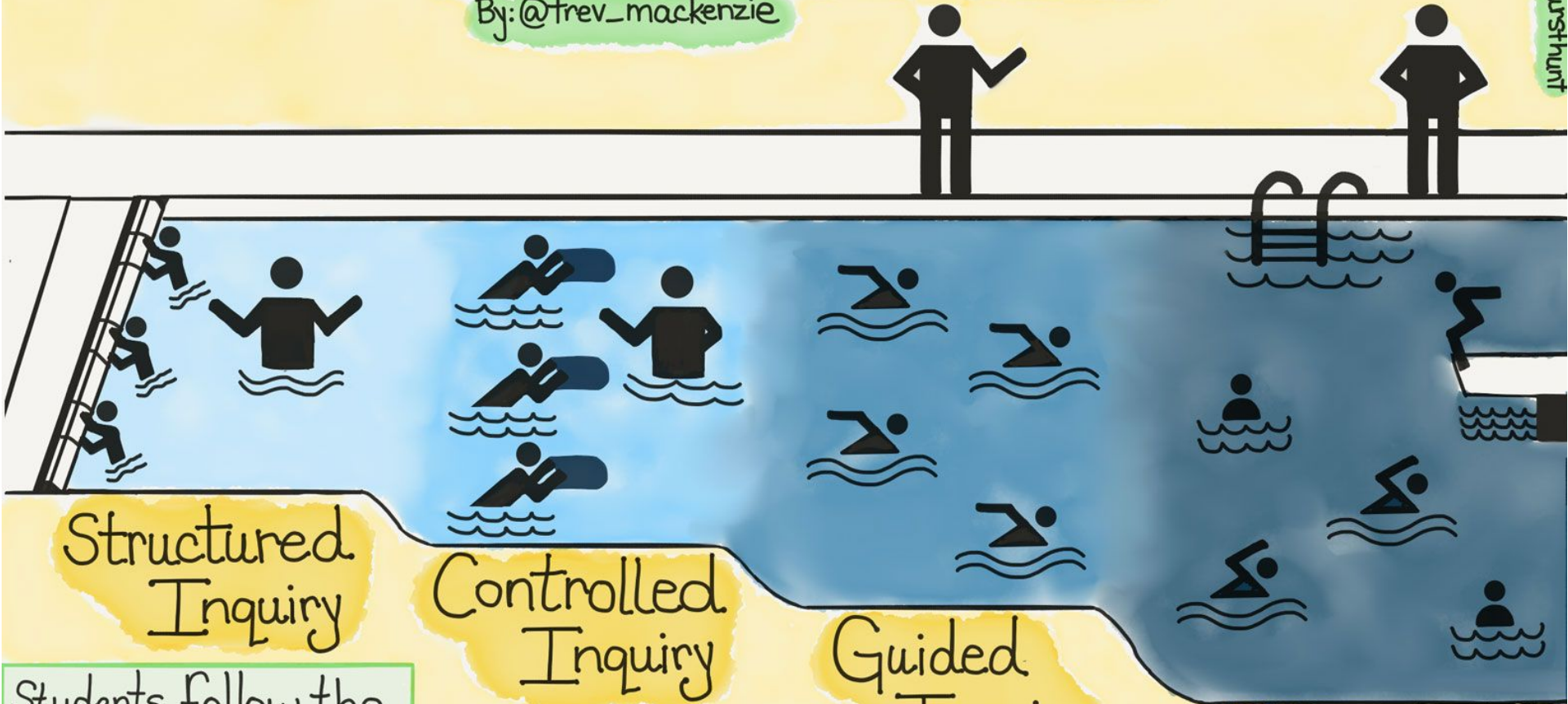


# Types of Student Inquiry

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## Structured Inquiry

Students follow the lead of the teacher as the entire class engages in one inquiry together.

## Controlled Inquiry

Teacher chooses topics and identifies the resources students will use to answer questions.

## Guided Inquiry

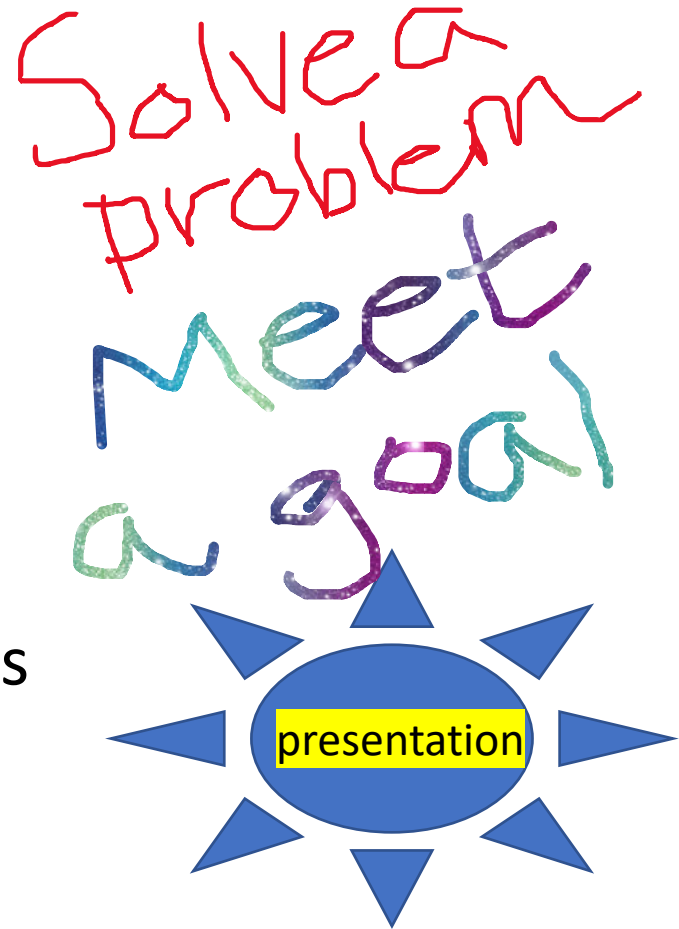
Teacher chooses topics/questions and students design product or solution.

## Free Inquiry

Students choose their topics without reference to any prescribed outcome.

# 5 Steps of Passion Project

1. **Explore**: Question, Brainstorm (KWL)
2. **Hypothesize**: What needs further investigation?
3. **Plan & Investigate**: Research
4. **Analyze & Interpret**: Plan your presentation of results
5. **Reflect**: What did you learn through this inquiry process? (Back to Step 1)
