Dear Lincoln Public Schools Families,

Happy February vacation! Whether you are staying home or traveling next week, I hope you are able to spend time with family and friends.

I wanted to provide a brief update about the school calendar. Per state requirements, the School Committee each year creates a calendar that includes the possibility of five snow days. This can be a little confusing, especially for families that are new to Massachusetts, because it can make the school year look like it has 185 days (instead of 180), and it can make the last day of school look later than it may actually end up being.

So, [on the school calendar](#) it looks as though the last day of school is June 20th, but that date builds in the state-required five snow days. Now that we have had one (admittedly somewhat anticlimactic) snow day, the 180th day of school is actually Thursday, June 13th. If we do not have any additional school cancellations, then June 13th will be the last day of school. If we have any additional cancellations, then the last day of school will get pushed back.

I am holding off on updating the calendar online until we have gotten through the snow season. Once we are clear of any additional weather events, we will post a final calendar that reflects the updated last day of school. But for now, the last day has been revised to be June 13th.
