

# Two Column Notes

1. Fold paper or Draw a line down the center.
2. Main ideas are recorded on the left-hand side.
3. Subtopics are recorded on the right-hand side, along with supporting details.

## ADDITIONAL USES

- Two-column notes work well across content areas.
- When paper is folded, this can also be used for self-testing.

equilateral triangle	- 3 congruent sides - 3 congruent angles - equal
right triangle	- has a $90^\circ$ angle
isosceles triangle	- 2 congruent sides - 2 congruent angles - "I saw Celesel!"
scalene triangle	- no sides congruent - no angles congruent
