



FUNDING PROPOSALS AND APPLICATIONS

The School Committee will encourage the administration to seek out and secure all possible sources of state, federal, and other special funds that will enhance the educational opportunities for the children in our schools.

The Superintendent will strive to keep informed of possible funds available to the school system under the various state and federal programs and in what manner these funds can best be used in the school system.

The School Committee encourages the Superintendent and/or designees to seek out and coordinate the development of proposals for specially funded projects.

The Superintendent and their designees will ensure that any specially funded projects are aligned with the district mission, goals, and priorities.

All specially funded projects or proposals exceeding \$30,000 will be presented to the School Committee for approval prior to the development of an application or proposal.

Annual entitlement grants, including but not limited to Title I, Title II, METCO, Special Education, and Early Childhood Special Education Allocation grants, do not require School Committee approval.

The Superintendent is authorized to sign all reports for these projects and will be responsible for the proper expenditure of funds received for such projects.
