School Calendar Holiday Preferences Survey - DRAFT

The school committees for Lincoln Public Schools, Sudbury Public Schools, and Lincoln-Sudbury High School are reviewing the school calendar and would like your input.

Proposals under consideration include:

- Adding Diwali, Eid al-Fitr, Eid al-Adha, and Lunar New Year as additional holidays (would lengthen the school year by up to 4 days).
- Removing Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, and Good Friday (would shorten the school year by up to 3 days, leaving only state and federal holidays).
- Rotating a small number of non-state/federal holidays each year from a shared pool.
