Goal 1: Sense of Belonging - Accomplished

- Hub leaders - designed to give students a leadership opportunity, chosen, work begun in December and picked up again in February
- Hub expectations are clearly articulated by hub
- Worked as a full faculty to re-think the definition how we respond to student behaviors
- Success plans for student behaviors in classes

Hub and other student Leader's Work

Created 2 surveys to check in with students

- 24% increase in number of students who can identify an adult with whom they are comfortable in the school
- 84% of students feel that adults hear them when they have a social issue - up from 80%

Lunch options and schedules surveyed - meeting with Cathleen Higgins today

Students introduced 4Cs - Care, Commitment, Communication, Cooperation to peers

Student Council created Art-a-Thon to enliven the hallways of the new school

- Success analysis protocol




Sense of Belonging - Not Yet

- Student learning walks


Goal 2: Teaching and Learning
