# Lincoln Public Schools Student Feedback Survey Results April 2018

#### Introduction

Each year since 2015, all of our students in grades 3-8 have had the opportunity to provide feedback to their 3-5 classroom teachers and 6-8 ELA, math, science, and social studies teachers through a student feedback survey. Faculty are provided with reports, with all student responses anonymized, that inform their practice and the development of professional practice goals. Survey results are grouped by topics, including both district priorities and the DESE Teacher Standards. Individual questions may contribute to more than one topic.

#### Grades 3-5 Survey


Students in grades 3-5 are surveyed about their primary classroom teacher. This year, 337 student responses were collected.


Across the four years that the survey has been administered, results by topic are fairly consistent, with no topic varying by more than +/- 5 percentage points over the four years of the survey.

In all four years, students in grades 3-5 responded most positively about the topics of Assessment & Feedback, Growth Mindset, DESE Standard I.B. Assessment, and DESE Standard I.A. Curriculum & Planning.

Students consistently responded least positively about the topics of Student Interest, Students Working with Students, DESE Standard I.C. Analysis, and DESE Standard II.A. Instruction.

The consistent results by topic are reflected at the question level, with few showing substantial changes across years. The only individual 3-5 questions that showed a significant change from






#### Grades 6-8 Survey


Students in grades 6-8 are surveyed about two of their ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies teachers, selected at random. This year, 574 student responses were collected.

As with the 3-5 survey, we see fairly consistent results by topic across years when looking at both district priorities and elements of the DESE Teacher Standards. Across all topics, there was a consistent drop from SY15 to SY16, which may reflect an undetermined effect related to our first year of student survey implementation.

Consistently, students responded most positively in the topics of Growth Mindset, Cognitive Demand, and DESE Standard I.A. Curriculum & Planning. Across all years, the lowest levels of positive responses have been in Student Interest, Students Working with Students, and DESE Standard II.A. Instruction.

Within the grade 6-8 topics, we generally see the same pattern of consistency from year to year on individual questions. An exception to this is the question "If we finish our work early in class, my teacher has us do more challenging work." The





percentage of students responding positively to this question has steadily increased ———— from 55% in SY15 to 63% in SY18.

#### Overall Trends

Looking across both 6-8 and 3-5 surveys, three 3-8 trends emerge. First, Growth Mindset is a topic of strength across both grade spans, likely reflecting prior commitments to professional development in growth mindset and the resulting teaching practices. Second, the topics that are student-centered, Student Interest and Students Working with Students, are lowest at both grade ranges, suggesting a need 3-8. Finally, at both grade spans, positive student responses have decreased on specific questions about behavior.
