At Hanscom Primary School we currently have:

- four K teachers
- three grade 1 teachers and one opening due to shift of grade 1 teacher to Therapeutic Learning Center position (may be covered with a grade shift)
- watch grade 2; we currently have two grade 2 teachers and an opening due to a teacher on a one-year leave of absence for 2019 2020.
- watch grade 3; we currently have four grade 3 teachers.
- We have 16 projected sections and 13 current sections. I anticipate that we will have at least 14 sections.

Principal Ledebuhr is watching his enrollment to determine how best to form teams and staff each team. He anticipates continuing combined 6/7 and 7/8 teams with additional planned staffing to support higher enrollment areas.
