Charge to the Committee

Develop recommendations for improvements to the district's current system of reporting on student progress, including report cards and conferences. Recommended improvements should help the district better meet the needs of students, families, and educators.

Parameters

- 2. Not consider shift away from standards-based approach
- 3.Keep both report cards and conferences

Two concurrent truths

Parents did not identify reduction in reporting periods as a priority.

Committee believes reduction will promote improvements that <u>do</u> meet parent priorities.

What: More time for teacher reflection =

improved quality of reflection
