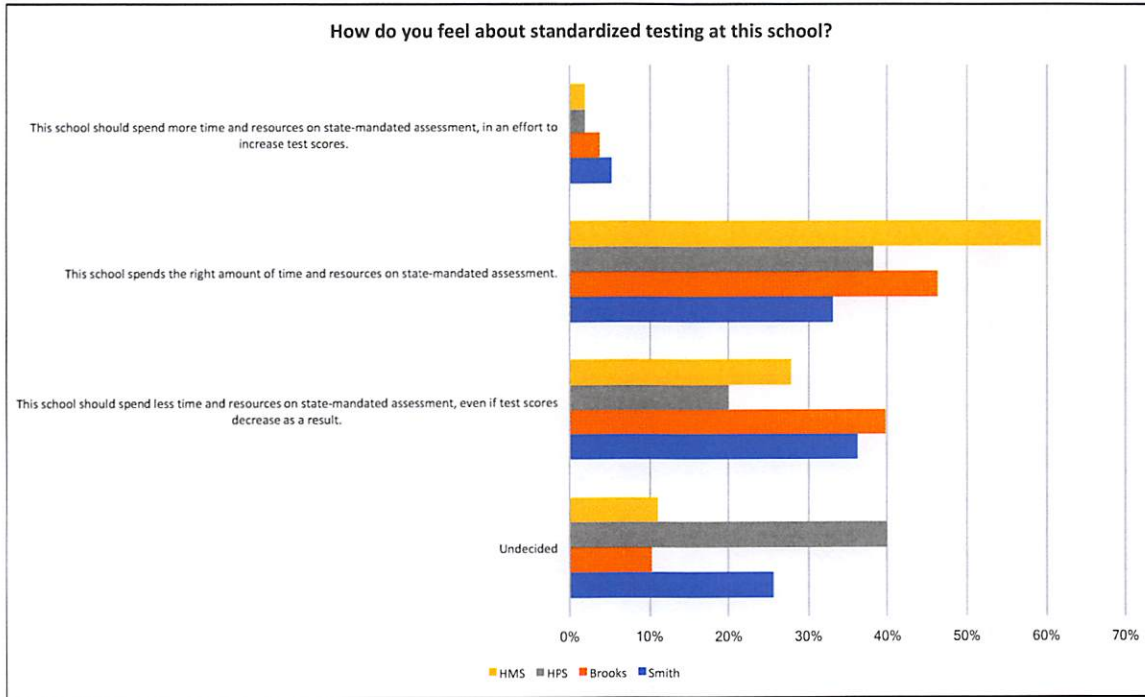




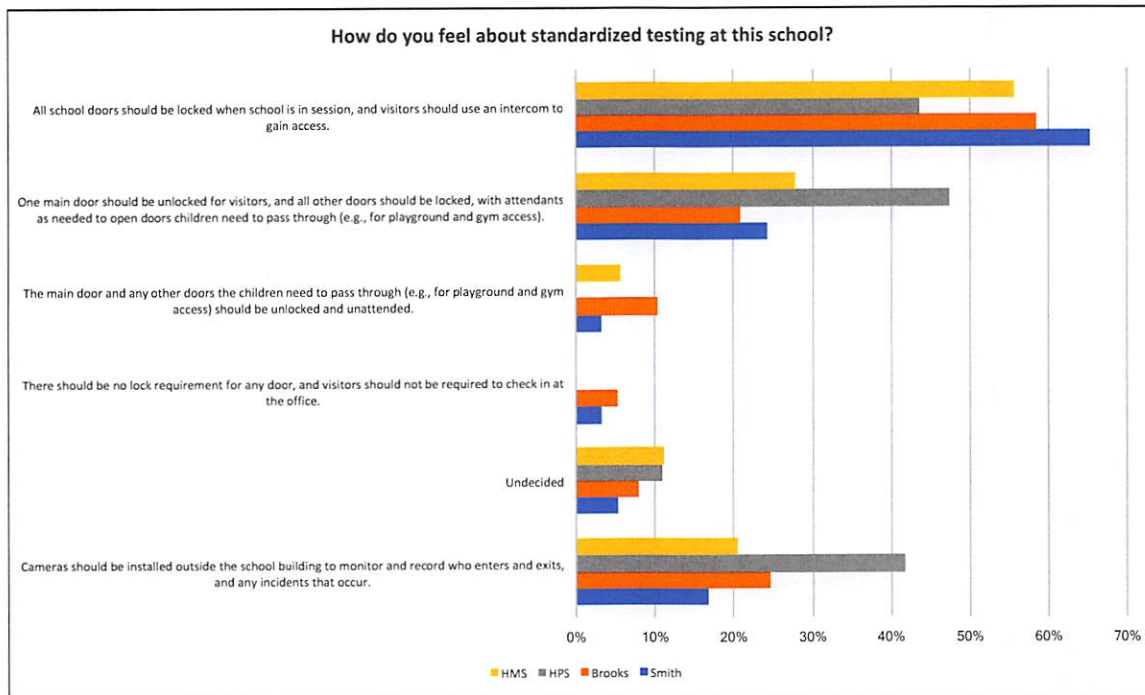
***How much confidence do you have in...***
