



Secondary Purpose - Overall District Strategic Planning for 2020 - 2021

How are these different?

Opening: Prepare for September through November based on guidance

Strategic Planning: What are our intended outcomes for the year, regardless of our instructional models (in-person/remote)?

What needs to be in place? - Training, Protocols, Equipment, Policies, Structures/Systems/Practices
