Re: Report on Summer Curriculum and Professional Development

Date: June 19, 2019

Overview

This year, there were a record number of applications for summer work and learning projects by LPS faculty. Similar to last summer, we have many small groups collaborating on targeted work. In nearly all cases, projects crystallized from ideas and needs that teachers voiced in the spring of 2019. I am quite proud of the significant increase in cross-campus work, where teams from Hanscom and Lincoln are joining together to embark on shared work. This week, the first projects of the summer began, and they will continue until the end of August, when teachers return for the 2019-20 school year.

Range of projects

The summer work projects, covering many curriculum areas, often involved teams coming together to craft or revisit curriculum, reflect on their instruction, or build a shared vision for the teaching and learning they will be leading in the coming school year. Multiple projects were based on revising or deepening existing bodies of work to sustain and strengthen important momentum from the prior school year.

Areas of Focus

This year's projects aligned with five areas:

- 1. Curriculum Development: Ten projects are explicitly about designing or revising curriculum. Many of these projects stem from updates to state frameworks or a result of investigating our curricular strengths and gaps.
- 2. *Interdisciplinary Team Work:* Multiple teams, particularly at Hanscom have invested in collaborative team projects or approaches to teaching and learning. These projects allowed complete grade level teams or interdisciplinary teams to work together strengthening old or creating new opportunities for students.
- 3. Developing (New) Instructional Skills: These projects are all focused on developing teacher's instructional skills in specific domains, building off of what teachers already know, and adding on new, sometimes more complex layers.
- 4. Social Emotional Learning Development: Both campuses are developing unique approaches to supporting a few targeted social and emotional student needs.
- 5. Teacher Leadership for Planning 2019-20: These groups all include faculty who will help to design and plan processes or potential resources for the upcoming school year.

At the culmination of each project's work, faculty provide updates and share products as well as evidence of their process. Whenever possible, I visit projects while they are happening to see faculty in action. I am looking forward to seeing the fruits of teams' collaboration in action throughout the year in classrooms all across our district.
