

**Lincoln Public Schools: Summer Projects 2023 School Committee Update  
September 7, 2023**

Starting on the first day of summer and ending on the last, the faculty of the Lincoln Public Schools participated in 29 separate projects. 123 contracts were created totaling \$98,940, which were funded through a combination of the FY23 and FY24 operating budget. A handful of projects were campus-specific, with work happening in both the Lincoln and Hanscom schools. A number of projects were cross-campus.
