ACADEMIC and BEHAVIOR SYSTEMS


Tier 3: Intensive, Individualized, Interventions. Individual or small group intervention.

Tier 2: Targeted, Strategic Interventions & Supports.

More targeted interventions and supplemental support in addition to the core curriculum and school-wide positive behavior program.

Tier 1: Core, Universal Instruction & Supports.

General instruction and support provided to all students in all settings.



VISION:

- An increased focus on Differentiated Instruction (DI) will lead to decreased calls to the Mental Behavioral Health Team (MBHT) as students are met where they need to be academically and emotionally.
- DI practices were at the core of elementary instruction prior to the pandemic; it is ever more important now.
