### **PPA Agreement – First Principles**

The Town decided to enter into a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) for several reasons.

Going "green" is important, smart, and required by Town bylaw.

But it is also complicated!

#### **PPA Agreement Update -- Summary**

After 2 years of negotiations, we convinced Eversource to allow first large scale "behind the meter" installation!

Critical to our project's financial viability – no distribution charges on 70% of our energy!

#### **PPA Agreement Update**

- Original PPA agreement signed March 2020 contemplated various pricing adjustments
- One adjustment in July 2021 was due to not being able to put panels on Auditorium and Gym roof sections
- Now we are negotiating "final" adjustments for increased labor costs, steel pricing, Eversource requirements, and O&M
- Still shooting for "on time" installation by late fall 2022 – if we get steel ordered soon!

#### **PPA Agreement Update**

- Operating budget for electricity for FY24 now estimated at \$280K - \$308K
- Assumes 1%/year escalator on PPA Rate
- Original discussion of intended "budget neutrality" was incomplete since PPA project is not "level services"
- Construction cost increases are hitting all projects
- Cost is still \$76K-\$96K lower in FY24 than using Eversource supply and adding "MA Class 1 RECs" to green up supply
- Ongoing need to be prepared for variability in output due to weather and in demand due to our usage
- But stability of energy pricing is a good thing!
