The Lincoln Public Schools will protect student privacy and safety when utilizing third-party software services by ensuring compliance with the Childrens' Online Privacy Protection Act, 15 U.S.C. §6501, et seq. (COPPA) and all existing district policies. If a third-party software service utilizes individual student accounts, the district will obtain consent from parents prior to issuing the account.

The district will maintain a publicly available list of third-party services used by students in the district. The services included on the list will be reviewed annually, and services will be added or removed as appropriate. During the course of the school year, teachers may propose the use of additional third-party services, and pending school and district approval, obtain consent from parents.
