STUDENTS SOCIAL EVENTS

The Superintendent shall encourage the staff, parents, and volunteers to plan activities that help children develop social skills appropriate to their age and maturity.

Student organizations and social events, except as noted in the policies of the School Committee, shall be self-supporting and financed by regulations established by the Superintendent. A continuing record of receipts and expenditures of each activity shall be kept by the separate schools and periodic financial statements shall be made to the Superintendent.

4 MASC School Districts have a policy on Student Social Events: This is a snapshot of what they contain.

All school functions held in the name of the school must be approved by the Principal and supervised by one or more faculty members or approved advisors.

All school functions such as dances, parties, etc., will be held in the school building, unless otherwise approved by the Principal and/or Superintendent.

Nonstudents will not be permitted to attend such functions unless so permitted by the building Principal.

Pupils present will be held liable for proper care of the facilities they use. It is understood that all existing rules of student conduct shall apply to social events.

All such activities must be adequately supervised by staff members.

Regulations may be established governing the specific events in the school. Such rules must provide for proper chaperoning at each event.
