Subject: FY14 Capital Projects Updates

**Background.** At its meeting on September 27, 2012, the School Committee approved two projects for submission to the Capital Planning Committee (CapCom). At its meeting on January 24, 2013 The School Committee proposed several additional projects for submission to the CapCom. The final prioritized list of projects was:

- 1. Replace Main Fire Alarm Panel \$100,000
- 2. Replace/upgrade Energy Management System (EMS) \$316,000
- 3. Increased Security Measures, Lincoln School -- \$40,000
- 4. Annual Classroom Rehabilitation and Preventive Maintenance Program -- \$75,000
- 5. Replace Wooden Window Curtain Walls and Insulate Masonry Walls, Hartwell Building Phase 1 -- \$105,000

**Update.** At its meeting on February 7, 2013, the CapCom made the following decisions:

- **FY14 Priority 1 -- Replace Main Fire Alarm Panel -** \$100,000 requested, \$36,000 approved, to fund replacement of the fire alarm panel only.
- FY14 Priority 2 -- Replace/upgrade Energy Management System (EMS) \$316,000 requested, \$0 approved.
- **FY14 Priority 3 -- Increased Security Measures, Lincoln School --** \$40,000 requested, \$40,000 approved.
- FY14 Priority 4 -- Annual Classroom Rehabilitation and Preventive Maintenance Program -- \$75,000 requested, \$75,000 approved.
- FY14 Priority 5 -- Replace Wooden Window Curtain Walls and Insulate Masonry Walls, Hartwell Building Phase 1 -- \$105,000 requested, \$105,000 approved.

Also approved was the request for \$400,000 to conduct architectural/engineering studies and designs to address facilities issues of the Lincoln School. This funding would support the next steps in the Lincoln School project.
