2023 - 2024 YEAR IN REVIEW: KEY ACTIONS OVER THE LAST 9 MONTHS

- Created and approved our Lincoln School Committee Goals for the 2023-2024 year
- Approved the <u>LPS Strategic Plan for the 2023-2024</u> year
- Participated in a professional development Budget Workshop led by the Massachusetts Association of School Committees (MASC)
- Held a Public Hearing on the FY25 Preliminary Budget
- Approved the FY25 Budget
- Approved all Federal and State Entitlement Grants
- Voted to approve FY25 fees for bus transportation, facility use, instrumental music lessons, athletic activities, and school lunch
- Approved grants for the Collins Center of UMass Boston to review and document our Hanscom Contract and district-wide Financial Processes and Procedures
- Approved the 2024-2025 School Calendar
- Attended a <u>METCO presentation</u> at METCO Headquarters to learn about the history of the METCO program and received a Lincoln METCO program update
- Approved the Superintendent's <u>Annual Plan for Evaluation</u>
- Reviewed district administration presentations on <u>MCAS results</u>, <u>Special Education</u>, and <u>Responsive Classroom / Social Emotional Learning</u>
- Reviewed <u>School Improvement Plans</u> for all district schools, as well as <u>end-of-year</u> outcomes.

- Participated in collective bargaining for our Education Support Professionals and our Food Services employees
- Reviewed and approved updates to over 60 policies in Sections B, E, F, H, K, and L of the <u>School Committee Policy Manual</u> to align with Massachusetts Association of School Committees (MASC) guidance and Massachusetts General Law

 - Boston Business Technology: developing and offering a Financial Capability program to Lincoln and Hanscom students as well as their parents/caregivers

- Reviewed the Superintendent's <u>mid-cycle progress towards goals</u>, and performed a mid-year evaluation of the Superintendent
- Conducted a mid-year review of the School Committee's annual goals
- Conducted the 2023-2024 School Choice Public Hearing, voted to decline participation in the School Choice Program for 2024-2025 school year
- Reviewed the Superintendent's Entry Plan Findings
- Approved the <u>LEAP license of Pod C</u> for the 2024-2025 school year
- Appointed the Superintendent to the Board of Directors of the CASE Collaborative
- Reviewed the <u>Hanscom Contract Review</u> issued by the Collins Center of UMass Boston
- Reviewed the revised AIDE Plan which will become our AIDE Guide going forward (link to draft AIDE Guide)
- Created a year-end newsletter
- Conducted a review of all Warrants
