Subject: FY11Capital Project list – approved by CPC

A list of projects approved by the Lincoln Capital Planning Committee (CPC) for consideration at the March Town Meeting is attached. Also attached is an updated version of the 5-Year Capital Plan, showing the revised amounts. Some details of proposed revisions to the plan to match the approved amounts follow.

- FY11 Priority 1 -- Annual Classroom Rehabilitation and Preventive Maintenance Program \$75,000 requested \$75,000 approved.
- FY11 Priority 2 -- Reseal Seams, Brooks Roofs \$55,000 requested \$55,000 approved.
- FY11 Priority 3 Replace/Seal Asphalt Paving, Various Locations on the Lincoln Campus \$60,915 requested – \$21,000 approved. The project estimate consists of the following amounts

	Sealing Smith lot	\$12,750
0	Smith lot entrance & exit replacement	\$15,870
0	Sealing Hartwell lot	\$ 5,225
0	Brooks roadway corner	\$15,870

The administration proposes bidding out the first two items: resurfacing the Hartwell walkways and sealing the Smith parking lot. We will explore reforming the Hartwell project by grinding the surface and applying a 2" overlay, rather than digging up the existing pavement, re-levelling the subbase and installing a new 2" base and 1" surface course of asphalt.

- FY11 Priority 4 -- Hartwell Asbestos Abatement Phase 2 \$31,500 requested \$28,000 approved. This project would abate vinyl asbestos tile (VAT) and replace with vinyl composition tile (VCT) in three areas:
 - Lincoln Preschool Two classrooms. One of the classrooms is the old Recreation Department office area, which has carpetting adhered to the underlying VAT.
 - District Office support areas (Kitchen, Food Service & Maintenance office areas.
 The VAT adhesive is releasing in several areas, creating the problem of crumbling tiles.
 - Entrance hallway near the Magic Garden entrance This high-traffic area has received significant wear and is hard to maintain.

The administration proposes bidding out all three items, requesting prices for each area. The first two would receive the priority of effort. If the prices for all three do not come in within the warrant amount, we will see if the difference to accomplish the third task can be made up from other sources

- FY11 Priority 5 Telephone System Upgrade \$ TBD [T] Remains on hold.
- FY11 Priority 6 -- Exterior Painting, Wooden Curtain Walls Schools & Pods Phase 2 \$28,000 requested \$25,000 approved. We will bid the job with several options, and ensure that the project stays within the budget.
- FY11 Priority 7 -- Replace Maintenance Vehicle and Purchase Trailer \$36,000 [T] requested \$0 approved. We will resubmit the project next year for reconsideration by the School Committee.
