

## Summer Projects 2022 School Committee Update

September 1, 2022

Starting on the first day of summer and ending on the last, Lincoln faculty participated in 32 separate projects. 172 contracts were created totaling \$73,020, which were funded through a combination of grant funding (274, Title II, Title IV) and the FY22 and FY23 operating budget. A handful of projects were campus-specific, with work happening in both the Lincoln and Hanscom schools. A far greater number of projects were cross-campus.
