Establishment of compensation levels for principals and other non-bargaining unit administrators.

M.G.L. c. 71, § 59B provides that, “[t]he superintendent of a school district shall appoint principals for each public school within the district at levels of compensation determined in accordance with policies established by the school committee...” Accordingly, the superintendent and the school committee shall meet on an annual basis to determine the range of salary increases that the superintendent may negotiate with principals and other non-bargaining unit administrators. The superintendent shall have discretion when negotiating salary increases to work within the compensation range agreed upon and authorized by the school committee.
