
- 1. Why does it start in grade 3?

# **Information Literacy**

The ability to access, evaluate, interpret and communicate information from a variety of sources.

#### Lincoln Research Process

- 1. Identify information need
- 2. Seek information
- 3. Locate information
- 4. Use and interpret information
- 5. Synthesize and communicate information
- 6. Evaluate research and process

# Identify Information Need

- What is my problem or question?
- What do I need to know?
- What am I curious about?
- What are key words related to my topic?

# Use and Interpret Information

- Read and collect facts and information
- Decide if source matches problem
- Organize information to address questions
- Add questions as needed to clarify information
- Begin to evaluate information for sharing value
- "Working Bibliography," will become "Works Cited," list
