ARTICLE _____

To amend the vote taken under Article 30 of the March 28, 2015 Town Meeting raising and appropriating the sum of \$750,000, contingent upon a Capital Outlay Exclusion, which was approved at the March 30, 2015 Town Election, for a Feasibility Study to develop building project renovation choices for the Lincoln School located at Ballfield Road, only in the event the Town was invited to participate in the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) Grant Program, **to instead** provide that such funds shall be used for a Feasibility Study, conducted by a School Building Committee jointly appointed by the School Committee and the Board of Selectmen, including all costs incidental and related thereto, to assist the School Committee, **independent of the MSBA**, in developing building project choices for the Lincoln School, located at Ballfield Road, noting that the School Committee is committed to a project that serves the district's educational goals, meets long-term facilities needs, builds on the work of previous committees, and engages the community in an inclusive process understanding such project will likely require a MINIMUM Town investment of \$30 million; or take any other action relative thereto.
