**SMOKING**

The Lincoln School Committee, recognizing that the health of students and employees is a matter of concern and that there are harmful effects of primary and secondary smoke, has declared that the school environment be smoke free. Smoking or any related activities of any substance, in any form, by any person, therefore, is not permitted at any time in school buildings, school buses or on school grounds.

The success of this policy will depend upon the thoughtfulness, consideration, and cooperation of smokers and nonsmokers. All individuals on school premises share in the responsibility for adhering to and enforcing this policy. Any individual who observes a violation on school property may report it to the appropriate supervisor.

Principals and Central Office Administrators are responsible for the enforcement of this statute. If necessary, the Lincoln Police Department or Hanscom Security Police will be asked for assistance.

Any violation of this policy by students shall be referred to the Building Principal. Individuals who violate the provisions of this policy will be subject to appropriate disciplinary actions.
