MANAGEMENT TEAM

The principals serve as the link between the individual buildings and the system as a whole. At the building level, it is their responsibility to provide educational leadership, to evaluate personnel, and to assess the needs of the particular school populations they serve. System-wide, the principals will meet together on a regular basis with the Superintendent and other central office staff to discuss educational needs, share ideas, resolve problems and coordinate program. By these meetings, they will keep both the Superintendent and other administrative personnel fully informed of all changes in program that they are contemplating at a building level. Using this management organization assures the School Committee that not only are individual needs understood and addressed, but that an overview of the whole school system is maintained. A primary assumption is that the Lincoln Public Schools is one school system and that the Superintendent must implement excellent instruction in all schools which comprise the system.
