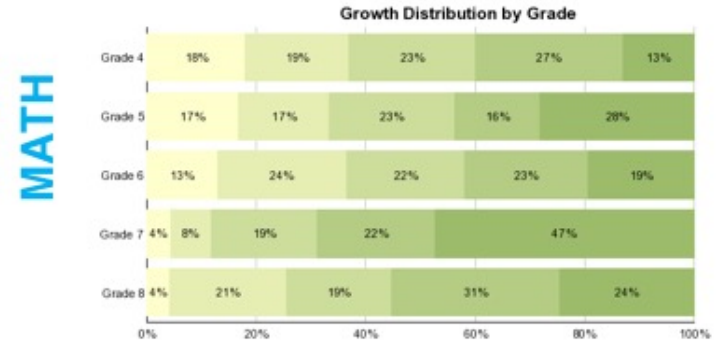

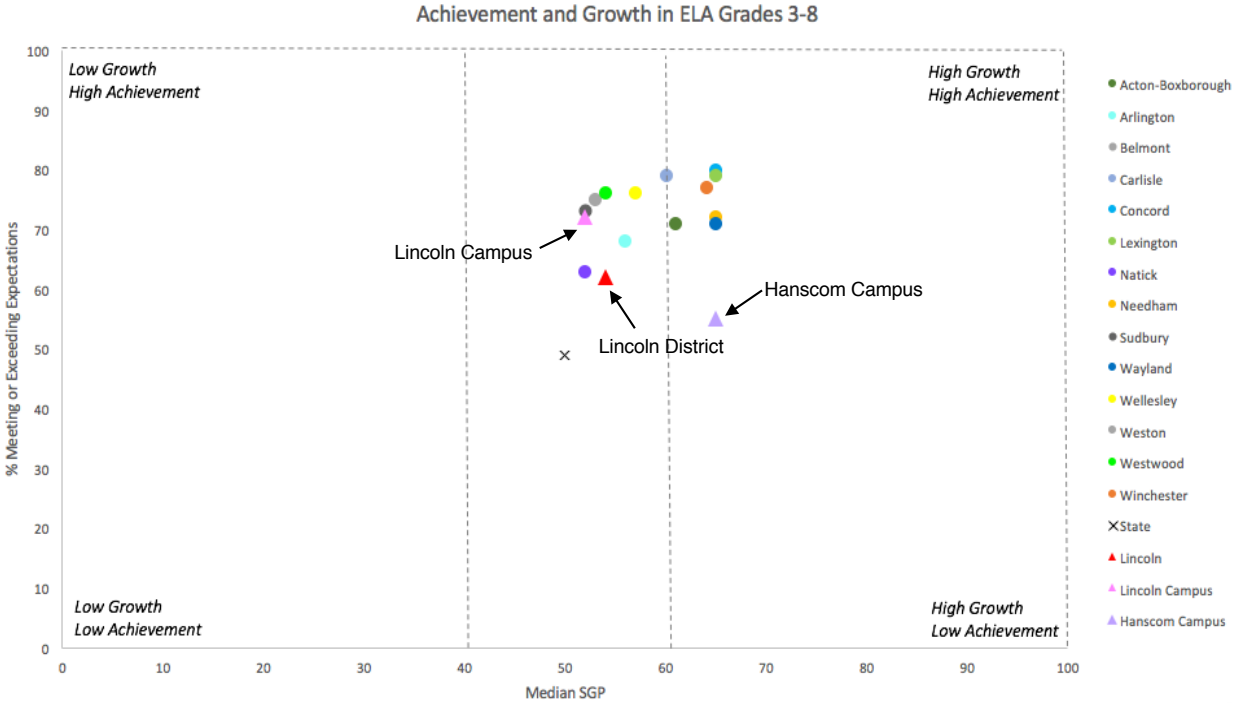

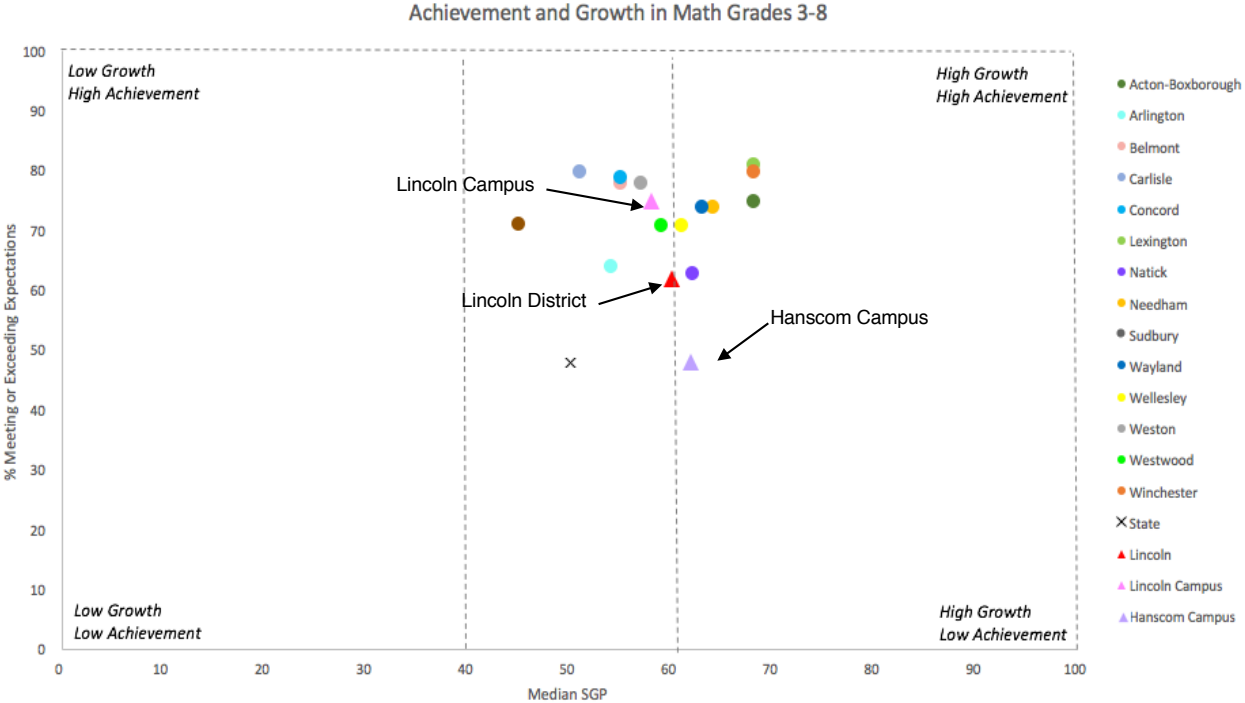

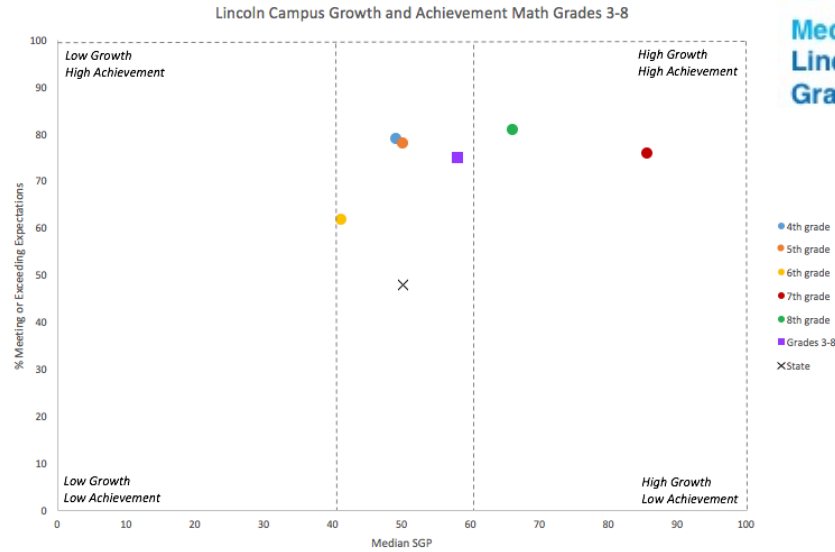

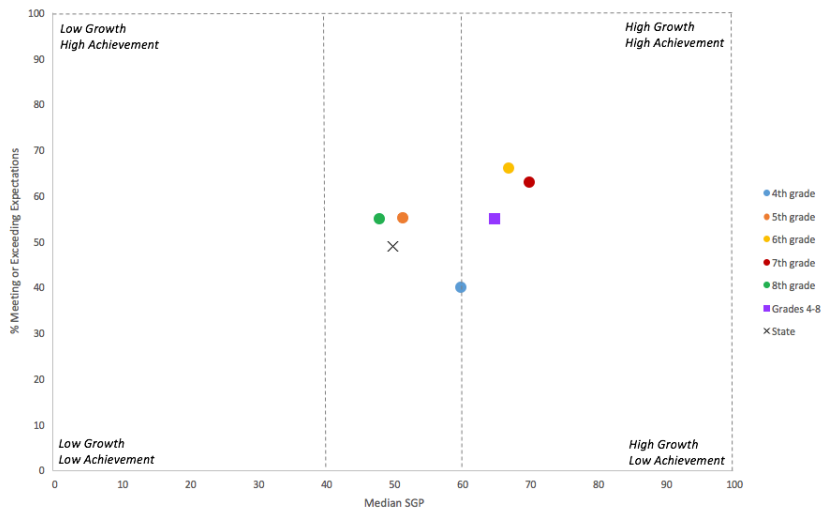

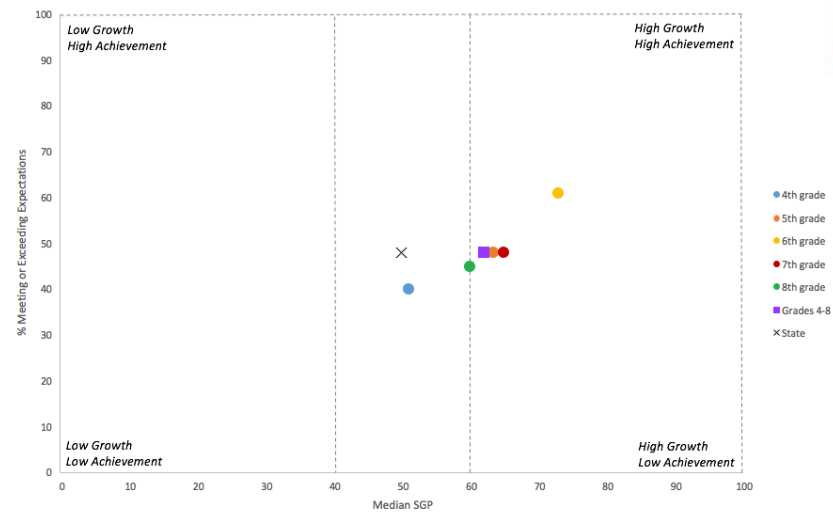

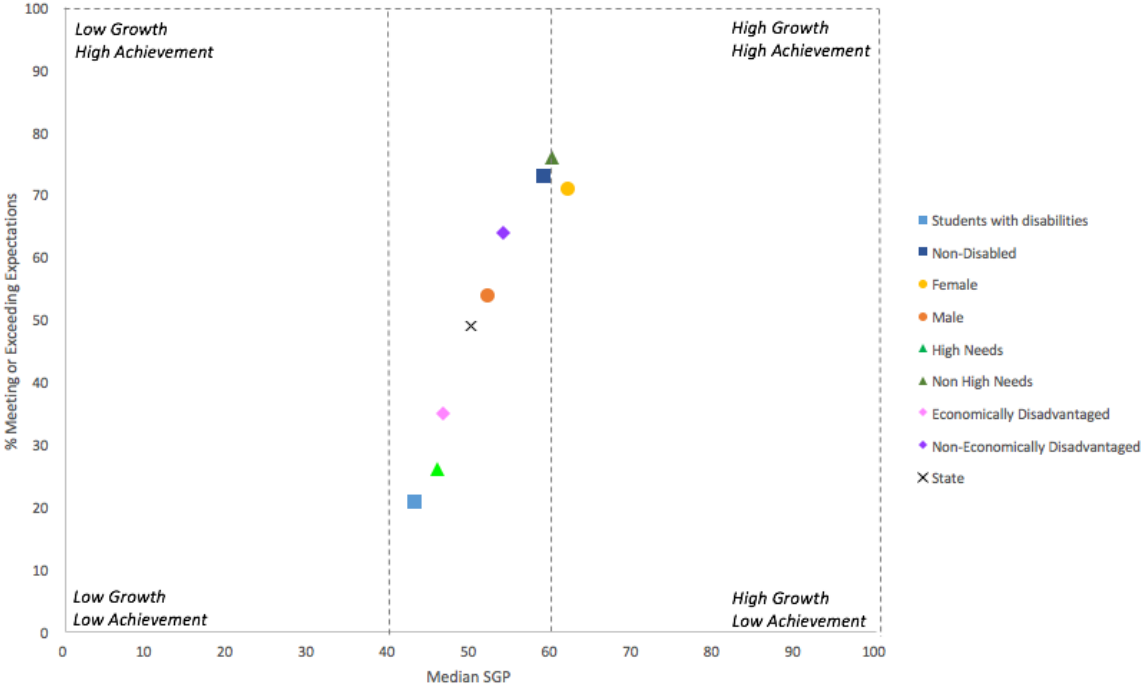


Hanscom Campus Growth and Achievement Math Grades 4-8

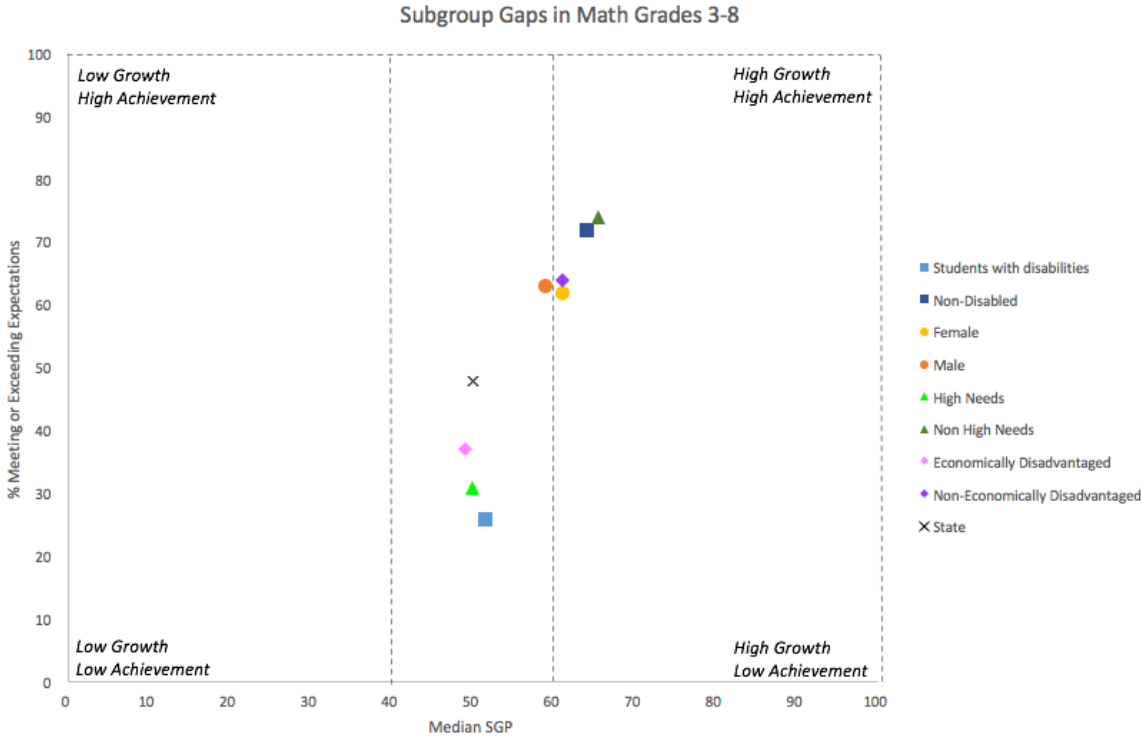


Gaps Between Subgroups: ELA

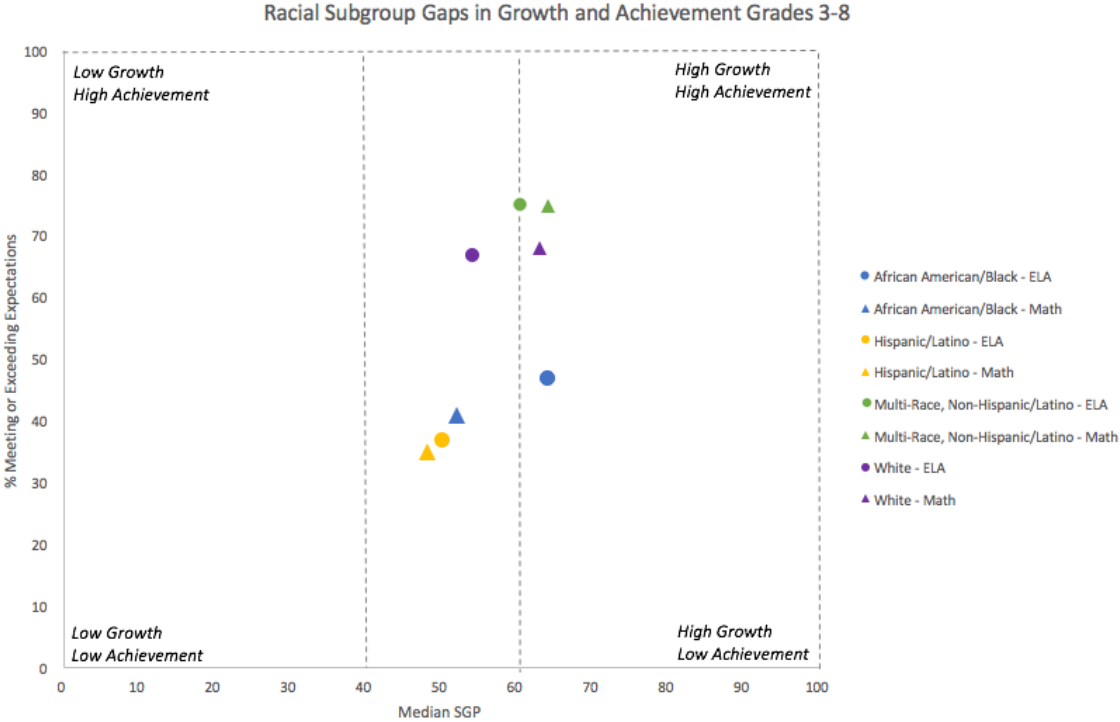
Subgroup Gaps in ELA Grades 3-8

Gaps Between Racial Subgroups: Growth and Achievement

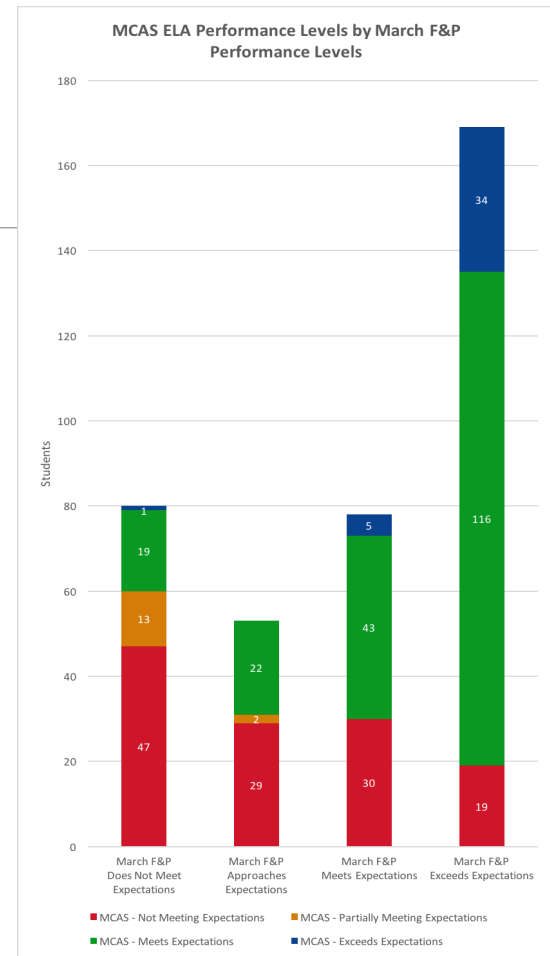

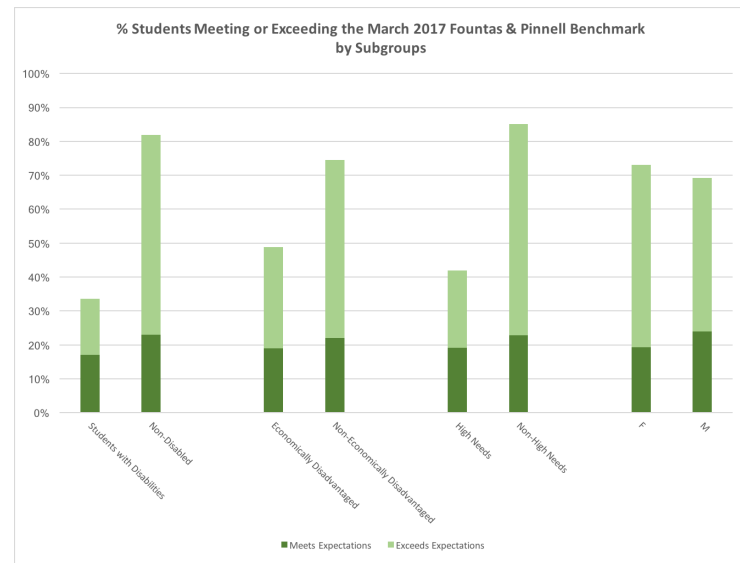
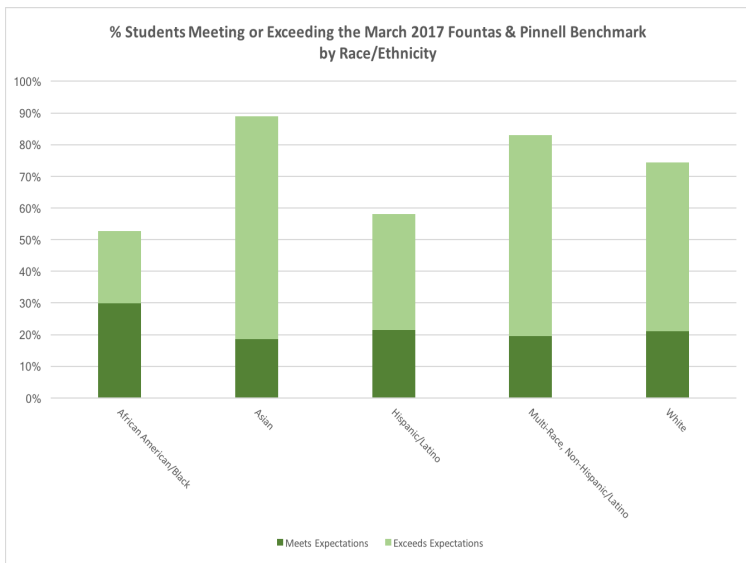
