The children will be working on retelling, predicting and sequencing events.



Our January learning targets are the following:

boots, hat, mittens, and shoes to wear in the classroom). Please label these items with your child's name.

As we promote independence, please send your child with clothing options that will be easier for him/her to manipulate and attempt independently. Often times, mittens vs. gloves are better for school based on the number of children getting ready at one time and the amount of time we have for preparation and outside time.
