# Who was surveyed?

## Remote students

- Learning mode for Spring 2021
- Transportation if switching to in-person
- 217 students
- Response rate: 100%

## In-Person students not currently riding the bus

- Opportunity to switch to riding the bus
- 184 students
- Response rate: 94%
